The Al Underys Engineering, Metallurgical & Material Sciences Memorial Scholarship is a \$2,500 scholarship award that will support ten students yearly in their studies. Scholarship recipients will be matched with an FIA member company to complete an internship in the forging industry.

Eligibility:

- Be high school seniors or current undergraduate or graduate students who are majoring in chemical, computer, electrical, industrial, materials, mechanical or metallurgical engineering at a four-year college or university
- Have a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.75 on a 4.0 scale (or equivalent)
- Be willing to consider a paid internship at an FIA member company

All eligible individuals who have completed the application process will be screened by Scholarship America and finalists will be selected by the Forging Foundation Board of Trustees. Deadline for applications is April 14, 2022.
